Some suggestions for snow days!

Play Snow (Not Food)

1/2 c. Suave conditioner 3 c. baking soda Good for sensory activity. (Compliments of Sandra Dollen, IFAPA Peer Liaison)

Peanut Butter Play Dough

1/2 c. creamy peanut butter 1/4 c. honey 1/2 c. dry powder milk Mix above ingredients. Use raisins, chocolate chips and pretzels to make "creative critters."
