

Darkness to Light's Stewards of Children Child Sexual Abuse Prevention

This training integrates the simple principles of consciousness, choice, personal power, and relentless compassion to promote an understanding of the nature and impact of child sexual abuse and uses those principles to provide a context for empowered action. This course is motivational and compelling. It calls you into personal responsibility for the safety of children while at the same time appreciates your fears and concerns. Participants will learn the impact of child sexual abuse, learn how to decrease risk for children and their own personal liability, and learn age and gender-specific behavioral warning signs.
