Anger De-Escalation (*6 hrs credit*) - This workshop explores the various primary emotions embedded within anger and the way they manifest themselves in foster and adoptive children's lives and in our own. Issues of separation, loss and grief will be presented as the genesis of anger demonstrated in foster/adoptive homes. A role-play will launch participants into the defusing stage, followed by great new, practical and easy-to-use methods of discipline to add to a parent's strategy toolbox, all helpful in de-escalating anger in both kids and adults. This training will provide proven and effective methods to diminish unwanted behaviors that make life easier for all.
