Caring for Children Who Have Experienced Trauma – Part 1 – Modules 5-8 (*7 hrs credit*) – In part 2 of this 2-part training series, participants will learn more ways to deal with problem behaviors caused by trauma effects on children. This training will give participants the basics of trauma-informed treatment and teach them to be advocates for their child, along with finding resources in the community. This portion of the trauma series will also focus on self-care for the parent. How secondary traumatic stress can affect you as a parent and what you can do to care for your own stress and compassion fatigue.
