



IFAPA TRAINING

Mandatory Child Abuse Reporter Training (*3 hrs credit*) - This is the state approved Mandatory Reporter class required for foster parents to complete within the first year of licensure, and then every five years thereafter. In addition, the Foster Allegation Information Resource (FAIR) program will be discussed. This is an IFAPA program that provides information and support to foster parents who have had an allegation of abuse made against them.

Trainer: Steven Hayward

Steven Hayward worked in Protective Services with the Iowa Department of Human Services as an Assessor of Child Abuse and Adult Abuse. He was named the state Program Manager for Child Protective Services in 1997, served as Policy and Procedure Training Instructor for Iowa DHS Child Abuse and Dependent Adult Abuse Core Courses, and is a founding Director and former Vice-President of “Children First – Children Cope with Divorce”. Mr. Hayward has compiled the training booklet “Child Abuse and Dependent Adult Abuse – A Guide for Mandatory Reporters”.
